

ORDINANCE NO. 201 1

**AN ORDINANCE OF NEWPORT TOWNSHIP, LUZERNE
COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-3 ADOPTING THE
QUALITY OF LIFE AND VIOLATIONS TICKET PROCESS IN
THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWPORT**

WHEREAS, Newport Township adopted Ordinance No. 2018-3, which adopted the Quality of Life and Violations Ticket Process within Township limits and setting forth penalties for violation thereof;

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to amend Ordinance No. 2018-3;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Commissioners of the Newport Township that;

Section 2. Definitions is hereby amended to include the following:

RECREATIONAL VEHICLES – recreational vehicles, motorized and non-motorized, shall include any boat, trailer, all-terrain vehicle (ATV) or other conveyance or article not specifically designed and adapted for the transportation of persons upon highways within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 3. Quality of Life Violations is hereby amended to include the following:

11. Motor Vehicles.


a. It shall be unlawful to store, park, or place any unregistered, uninspected, inoperative, unlicensed, or nuisance motor vehicle on any premises. No vehicle shall at any time be in a state of major disassembly, disrepair, or in the process of being stripped or dismantled. Painting of vehicles is prohibited unless conducted inside an approved spray booth.

b. No person shall store, maintain or allow to remain any recreational vehicle on the side of any public roadway located with the Township for a period exceeding twenty-four (24) hours.

Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
