The Commissioners of Newport Township have taken a major step in improving residents' Quality of Life. On August 6, 2018 they passed Ordinance 2018-3, which lays out specific requirements that encourage responsible behavior regarding a host of common sense activities. The Ordinance covers the following:

- Property Maintenance
- Littering
- Animal Waste
- Improper Storage of Trash and Rubbish
- Storage of Inoperable / Non Registered Vehicles
- Operations without Permits
- Snow / Ice Removal

Though it would appear that the above issues would normally be considered common sense and routine maintenance activities, Newport Township has instances where it is not common practice, thus the need for the Ordinance.

Ordinance 2018-3 provides for the assessment of significant and immediate fines when violations are discovered and cited by police officers and / or Code Enforcement Officials. Citizens are encouraged to review the Ordinance in its entirety to ensure complete awareness of all possible infractions.
